

**Class One: Watercolor Fundamentals**  
**Materials List**

**Graphite Pencils-** HB or 2B, mechanical pencils are also fine.

**Kneaded Eraser-** Soft, putty-like eraser that lightens drawings without fully erasing them for cleaner lines.

**White or Pink eraser**

**Cold Pressed Watercolor Sketchbook or Watercolor Pad- Any size**

\*Cold pressed means rougher textured paper, hot pressed means smoother paper; hot pressed is recommended for smooth drawing, but cold pressed will also work fine.

**Watercolour paint brushes, (Round)-** Size 03, Size 08, Size 12

**Watercolour Brush Pen(Any size)-** Fills with water and is then used to paint with water-colour anywhere.

**Water-colour Pan Set-** 12 to 24 Colours.

**Pencil Sharpener** -Preferably one that sharpens both coloured pencils and graphite.

**Sheets of paper towel or paper napkins**

**Fine-liner Pen-** Size 0.3' or larger, black, blue or red.

**Scrap or recycled paper-** for practicing drawing exercises or taking notes.

**Plastic or manilla file folder-** for storing practice sheets and notes.

**Plastic Ruler**

**Optional Supplies-**

**Tracing paper pad-** 8.5x11" or larger.

**Brush Pen-** A pen that is filled with an ink cartridge and allows for quick comic-book style inking.
