Explore Drawing in Various Mediums, Wednesday class, Feb. 18 – Mar. 25

- Pencils & eraser
- Sketchbook or pad of paper, standard 8X11” size or larger
- Textured paper such as watercolour paper and/or a pad of pastel paper in assorted colours
- Set of chalk pastels
- Charcoal pencils
- Optional: Watercolour set and brushes
- A few sheets of paper towels

Building a Painting with Debra Ward, Saturday class, Feb. 21 – Mar. 28

- Pencil and eraser
- Sketchbook or pad of paper, standard 8X11” size or larger
- Watercolour or acrylic paints: basic set is red, blue, yellow, umber(brown), titanium white.
 - Full set used by artists has a cool and a warm version of each colour: Quinacridone red and Cadmium red, Cyan or cerulean blue and ultramarine blue, Azo yellow and cadmium yellow, Burnt Umber, orange, sap green, violet, and Titanium white.
- Brushes: a combination of flats and filberts is best. One 1” inch flat for blocking in first shapes. Up to 3 filbert and flat in various sizes (#4 and #6 are most versatile). 1 #2 round detail brush.
- Plastic palette or a pad of palette paper to mix paint onto.
- A small spray bottle for water.
- Pad of canvas paper or canvas-board for acrylic painters.
- A pad of watercolour paper for watercolourists.
- Container for water, yogurt containers work well.
- Paper towels.

Landscapes: From Snapshot to Artwork, Wednesdays class, April 1 – May 6

- A clear landscape photograph with strong lights and darks.
- Pencil & eraser
- Sketchbook or pad of paper, for notes and practice sketches
- Set of chalk pastels or Pastel pencils
- Pencil crayons and sharpener
- Simple set of watercolours
- Textured paper such as watercolour paper, either a pad or sheets.
- Pad of pastel paper in assorted colours, Canson is good.
- A few sheets of paper towels

Still Life Studies: Pastel, Pencil & Charcoal, Wednesday class, May 13 – June 17

- Pencil & eraser
- Sketchbook or pad of paper, for notes and practice sketches
- Set of chalk pastels or Pastel pencils
- Charcoal
- Pencil crayons and sharpener
- 6 sheets of heavier paper such as watercolour paper
- Pad of pastel paper in assorted colours, Canson is a good brand.
- A few sheets of paper towels
